



Benavente clan plans reunion

Two years before John Cruz Benavente left the island in 1976, he arranged a get-together for his immediate and extended family for an Easter celebration.

Having recently returned this year, Benavente decided to take on a bigger challenge — to assemble the entire Benavente clan on island to celebrate Thanksgiving at Ipaog Beach.

Benavente said his relatives have always gathered together in small

groups but never collectively.

Greg Rosario Camacho, a Benavente descendant who is in charge of publicity for the reunion, said this is the first time in history a get-together of this magnitude has ever been planned for the Benavente family.

Camacho said they are planning to reunite at least 600 to 1,000 relatives. "I feel we're about 6,000 strong but this is just a start," he said.

But preparing for the reunion takes a lot more than just getting on the

phone and calling every Benavente on the island.

Benavente and Camacho said they established a central planning committee, which consists of seven people, that will direct five other committees to take care of the food, drinks, publicity, finance, and most important, genealogy.

Benavente said Juanita Benavente was assigned to trace the number of families that are somehow connected to the Benavente family tree.
